







The Annual Meeting of the Anti-Ragging Committee was convened on 26, July 2023 to review the progress made in the previous academic year.

\* In order to combat sexual harassment, strict and stern rules are followed by the college to develop principles and procedures related to a safer environment.






\* The Committee members arrange a meeting with all the hostellers and they are allowed to express their problems if any.
