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Subcommittees members and their responsibilities

1. Class Monitoring Committee (Student feedback mechanism on Faculty Performance)

The main objective of this committee is to collect the Student feedback on Faculty Performance. This committee comprises of 2 senior Faculty members in each Department.

- Faculty members who are not handling the particular class are given the responsibility of collecting feedback from students belonging to that class to ensure free and fair response.
- A structured proforma consisting of important parameters pertaining to teaching learning process has been designed for the purpose of collecting students' feedback.
- The responses and the results are analyzed by the HoDs and the Principal, and the feedback is communicated to the faculty members concerned wherever necessary, for their improvement.
- Students feed back on value added programme conducted (for example Guest lectures, seminars, Industrial visits , etc.) is obtained at the end of the programme by distributing questionnaire on the event.
- The feedback is entered into computer and the ratings given by students are calculated to arrive at a cumulative index which will denote the rating of the students for the faculty in a given subject. Further, parameter wise rating also noted for certain parameters to identify the strength and areas for improvements for the faculty. 5 – Excellent, 4 – Very Good, 3 – Good, 2 – Fair, 1 – Poor
- The subject knowledge, presentation skills, and the readiness of the faculty to help the students in case of clarifications, additional inputs given in the class and other factors could be inferred from the feedback.
- The inputs are communicated to the faculty members through HoD by the Principal for suitable improvements. Besides, the inference is discussed with the faculty members during the annual faculty appraisal.

2. Scrutinizing & Monitoring Committee for Academic Matters,

This committee comprises of Staff HOD, 2 senior faculty members.

- The main purpose of creating this committee is to monitor the uploading of all subject related contents such as class notes and assignment questions in the college portal.
- They should also verify the students' assignment book and their note books after submission in the department.

3. Placement & Higher Studies Coordination Committee

The committee comprises of Staff HOD, Placement coordinator, faculty members involved in placement orientation programme (POP).

- Preparing and maintaining students' data such as, University results, communication details, etc.
- Data sought by the placement office / ABHS should be submitted on the same day.
- Identifying Alumni mentors and coordinating the activities with our students.

4. Students' Activities Coordination Committee

The committee comprises of Students HOD, two senior staff members

- Motivating the students to take part in Symposia and Conferences in the institutions of high repute.
- Ensure that the students are given OD and bag prizes.
- Motivating the students to take up innovative projects, that can be nominated for awards like INAE.
- Conducting Department Club Activities under Students' Chapters,
- Department magazine editing

5. Industry–Institute Interaction Cell

This committee comprises of Lab HOD, one senior faculty with Ph.D, III cell coordinator, Department R& D coordinator,

- Securing funded consultancy assignments
- Planning and arranging for Industrial Visits.
- In-plant Training
- Planning and arranging for Guest Lectures for students as per gap identified.
- Identifying and organizing of Value Added Courses.

6. Entrepreneurship Development Cell

The committee comprises of Lab HOD, One senior staff member, EDP coordinator

- Organizing FDPs, Workshops for faculty members
- Maintaining NPTEL course materials
- Conducting e-IIT certification programs
- Planning and arranging for training the students to become entrepreneurs in coordination with Entrepreneurship Development Agencies of Government and University.
