#### <u>Minutes</u>

[3]Dr.N.Arunkumar, Coordinator,IQAC made a brief power point presentation highlighting the status of IQAC and the responsibilities set. Some of the salient features pointed out in the presentationwere:

- d. Green Audit, Water Audit, Waste Audit, Carbon Fibre Audit and Energy Audits results.
- e. Silver Jubilee Events Planning and organizing
  - i. To increase the number of journal publications.
  - ii. To increase the number of Funded projects.
  - iii. To encourage the students to undertake final year projects in industries
  - iv. Alternatively, industry sponsored projects to be taken up by the students in our college.
  - v. To encourage the students to participate in National level Technical Competitions like Hackathon and AICTE Viswakarma

[4] After the presentation there was an open discussion.

The following are the suggestions / comments from the externalmembers:

- a. Quality parameters need to be defined quantitatively and the bench marks need to be set.
- b. Learning basic concepts by the students need to be strengthened.
- c. More industry based workshops and Value added courses need to be organized and the students need to be involved in that.
- d. Develop the culture in students to take up the competitive examinations
- e. Develop parameters to improve Teahing Learning process. It should be more than the feedback from the students.
- f. Mechanism to evaluate the industry projects should be evolved

- a. To provide quantitative information for discussion during the next IQACmeeting.
- b. To come up with quantitative quality parameters at various levels and for benchmarking.
