

- [5] Department BOS meeting has been conducted for updation and modification in new syllabus for the students enrolling from the year 2021.
- [6] AICTE Awards- Our Institution has participated in various AICTE Awards such as, Vishwakarma Awards, Green and smart campus Awards.
- [7] NIRF Ranking Our Institution has participated in NIRF ranking 2021-22.
- [8] AICTE LILAVATI AWARD intends to recognize efforts being made by AICTE approved institutions to treat women with 'equality and fairness' in all spheres of their lives. Our College has received the Ist Runner-Up Award in AICTE LILAVATI AWARD-2021 under the sub theme "Women and Adolescent Health" conducted by the Ministry of Human resource and Development (MHRD), Government of India.
- [9] Our Students from the department of ECE, Biotech and Mechanical have received a total amount of 34.5 Lakhs for Business Model Development in the National Level Grant Challenge MSME IDEA HACKATHON-2022 organized by MSME, Government of India.
