

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

### PARENTS FEEDBACK CONSOLIDATED REPORT (ACADEMIC YEAR 2022- 23)

Feedback is collected from the parent of the students. The feedback form consisted of around twenty parameters. Each parameter is graded for satisfaction on a scale of 1 to 5. Some of the parameters accommodated in the parents feedback, include quality of teaching, students' discipline, lab facilities, examination system, student activities and other facilities such as transport, library, mess etc.

Feedback forms were sent to parents of all the students and only 50 responses were received. Only few of the parents have filled in all the parameters of the feedback form. 

- It is reported by the students that the teaching methods are effective.

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

- Enrollment in various online courses should be encouraged.




### DEPARTMENT OF MBA ALUMNI SURVEY – 2022 - 23

Alumni feedback was obtained from nearly 75 alumni for the academic year 2022 - 23. The institution believes that the contribution of alumni is essential particularly in the development of the curriculum related activities. An online alumni meet was organized and more than 120 registered for the meet and around 85 alumni participated. After the alumni meet a feedback form was circulated through Google forms and their feedback was sought. The feedback from the alumni revealed that they are willing to contribute to the development of the institution.

Majority of alumni rated the developmental activities rendered by the college for the overall development as highly efficient. Regarding the residential facilities, 35% of them who were in hostel rated that the food and accommodation facilities as highly efficient. Student teacher relationship, 90% of them rated that as highly Efficient. While expressing their view placement cell, 90% of them agreed that ample on campus and off campus opportunities were provided. Regarding career guidance and counselling, alumni felt, it can be made a little efficient and regular. The overall strength and weakness of the department from the alumni are summarized below.
