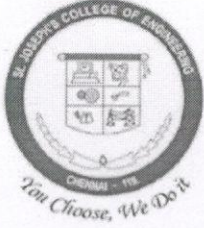

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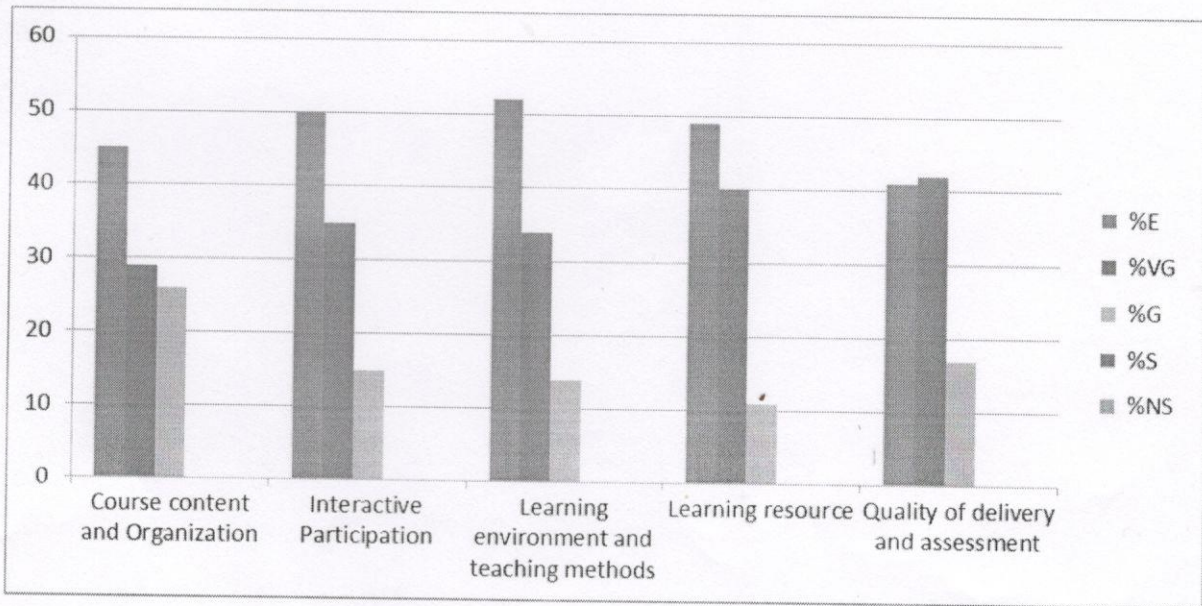

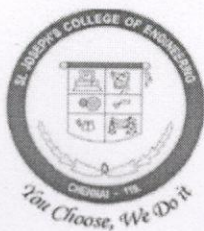

### FEEDBACK ANALYSIS:

Students are encouraged to respond to the feedback form as honest as they can and in a timely manner. The college has obtained feedback on curriculum from students through questionnaire which contains the following major aspects such as course content & organization, interactive participation, learning environment & teaching methods, learning resource and quality of delivery and assessment. Around 45% of student is satisfied with the course content. More seminars and Invited talks can be arranged in order to encourage the students. Academic support extended by the faculty has to be improved. 54% students are satisfied with the course material whereas some expects more reference books. Requisition process to be improved aiding raw material procurement for project work from maintenance department in order to increase the learning environment from 53%. Majority are satisfied with the Basic facility for doing experiments in each laboratory. Some of the students have suggested for gaps in between the assessment schedule. Totally 532 students gave their feedback on curriculum for the ACADEMIC YEAR 2018-2019.

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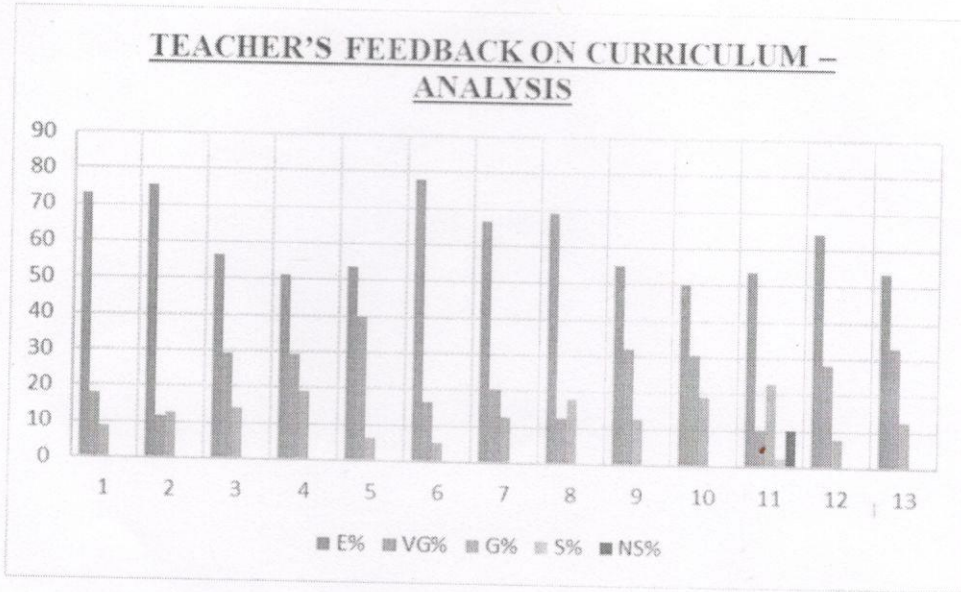
