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

Student's Feedback

The college has obtained feedback on curriculum from students through questionnaire which contains the following major aspects such as Course content & Organization, Interactive participation, learning environment & teaching methods, Learning resource and Quality ofdelivery and assessment. Totally 254 students gave their feedback on curriculum for theacademic year 2021-2022. 85% of the student's population agreed that the allocation of coursecontent is appropriate in relation to the level of course content is very much appropriate to the programme. Majority of the students strongly agreed that the interaction by teachers withstudents are more feasible and reliable. Around 87% of the students agreed that they are equipped with necessary teaching methods required for their programme. It is observed that 82% of the students agreed that the provision for learning resource in library was adequate and appropriate with their respective field of specialization areas. The feedback revealed that 83% of them are strongly agreed about the quality of delivery and the internal assessment for the specified programme. Some students are suggested that it would be helpful if the certification course with hands on training can be included as a part of the curriculum.

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

- Guest Lectures, Mini projects, Coding Competitions, Hackathons should be encouraged to bridge the gap in the curriculum.

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
